

**PLEASE HELP US SAVE THE GREEN BELT ON MAYS LANE, BARNET, BY STOPPING THE APPLICATION FOR RESIDENTIAL TRAVELLER CARAVANS**



The delayed Public Inquiry to decide whether to allow residential Traveller caravans on Mays Lane Green Belt began Friday 31<sup>st</sup> Jan and reconvenes on 20<sup>th</sup> March.

As the Rule 6 party, our role in the Inquiry is to represent the local community, in particular on grounds of objection that the Council has dropped (highways safety & flooding). We are the only party querying the appellant's lack of evidence of their need for *THIS* particular site. ***We are not duplicating the Council's position - we offer a crucial, unrepresented argument that the inspector will consider alongside the Council's case.***
